#### **2008 Highlights**

- Preached at St. Andrews UMC, Forth Worth, Texas during the 2008 General Conference of the United Methodist Church.
- Attended Chanukah Celebration at 214 Rossmore. Sponsored by the American Jewish Center (AJC).
- Met with “Senator Barack Obama” in a private meeting along with seven (7) other religious leaders to discuss his candidacy for the United States Presidency (Beverly Hilton Hotel).
- Made a presentation for African University at the Training for New District Superintendents and Bishops (Lake Junaluska, North Carolina).
- Presented a Workshop on Music and Worship at the “Great Event” (sponsored by Strengthening the Black Church for the Twenty-first Century) in Dallas, Texas.
- Traveled to Seoul Korea with a U.S. Delegation to visit and dialogue with Korean Christians.
- On November 4<sup>th</sup> – Voted for the first time for a Black Man for the United States Presidency.
- Interviewed by Chris Lawrence, CNN Correspondent for a show that aired Monday, November 10<sup>th</sup>.
