LEON DAVIS MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

Leon Davis



Leon Davis, a long-time member of Holman United Methodist Church, was born and raised in Brighton, Alabama. He attended Clark Atlanta University in Atlanta, Georgia and upon graduation enlisted in the United States Army. After his honorable discharge as a Sergeant, Leon moved to the Los Angeles area and completed the Masters of Business Administration (MBA) program in the Anderson School of Business at the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). While at UCLA, Leon met Beverly Taylor and after their graduation they were married. God blessed their union with two daughters, Keisa Michelle and Marisa Ellen.

Leon began his 32-year public service career with the City of Los Angeles in Mayor Tom Bradley's Office of Urban Development and was charged with developing the \$4.2 million Commercial Area Revitalization Program and was instrumental in the establishment of the Crenshaw Comprehensive Community and Economic Development Program which was used by Mayor Bradley to attract a seasoned shopping center developer to take on the task of renovating the renamed Baldwin Hills-Crenshaw Shopping Center. The Office of Urban Development eventually became the City of Los Angeles Housing Department. During his stellar career with the City of Los Angeles, Leon earned numerous promotions, held various managerial positions and demonstrated the highest standards of professionalism. Leon continued his professional growth by completing the Certificate in Real Estate Development at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in 1992, and the Certificate in Contract Compliance at Cleveland State University in 1994. Leon also played a pivotal role in the creation of the Real Estate Development Program, which teaches minority developers the principles of real estate development. The program evolved into the Ross Program in Real Estate Development which is taught at the University of Southern California.

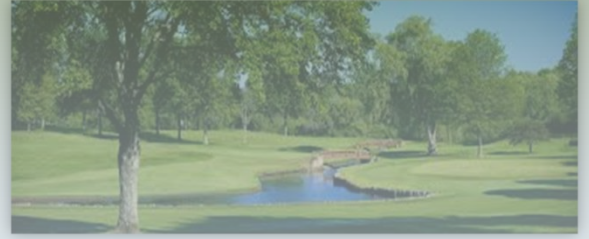
Leon loved the Lord and his church. At Holman United Methodist Church he served and participated in leadership positions in various ministries and projects. He was most passionate about his involvement in Holman's finance-related activities, especially raising funds to meet its World Service obligations, in teaching the Adult Sunday School class and Disciple Bible Study classes, his involvement in Holman's United Methodist Men (UMM) and ministries focused on youth. He was most excited by his recent role as creator/coordinator of the Literary Ministry and its inaugural project "Anthology of Creative Works by Members and Friends of Holman United Methodist Church".

Leon loved his family and really enjoyed playing golf. He was an individual of profound faith which was reflected in the manner in which he treated his family, friends and everyone he encountered. He was a caring individual who lived life to the fullest, whose generosity was extended to everyone and whose spirit will live forever in the hearts and memories of all his loved ones. Leon went home to be with the Lord on January 8, 2015.

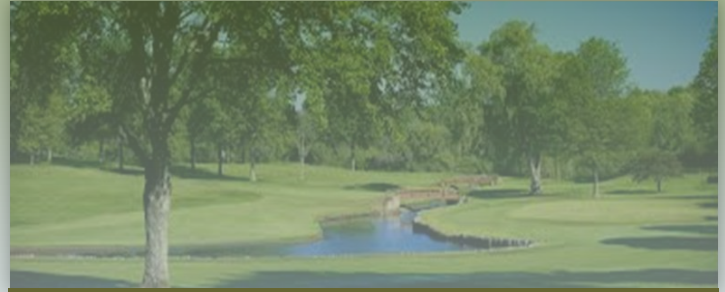

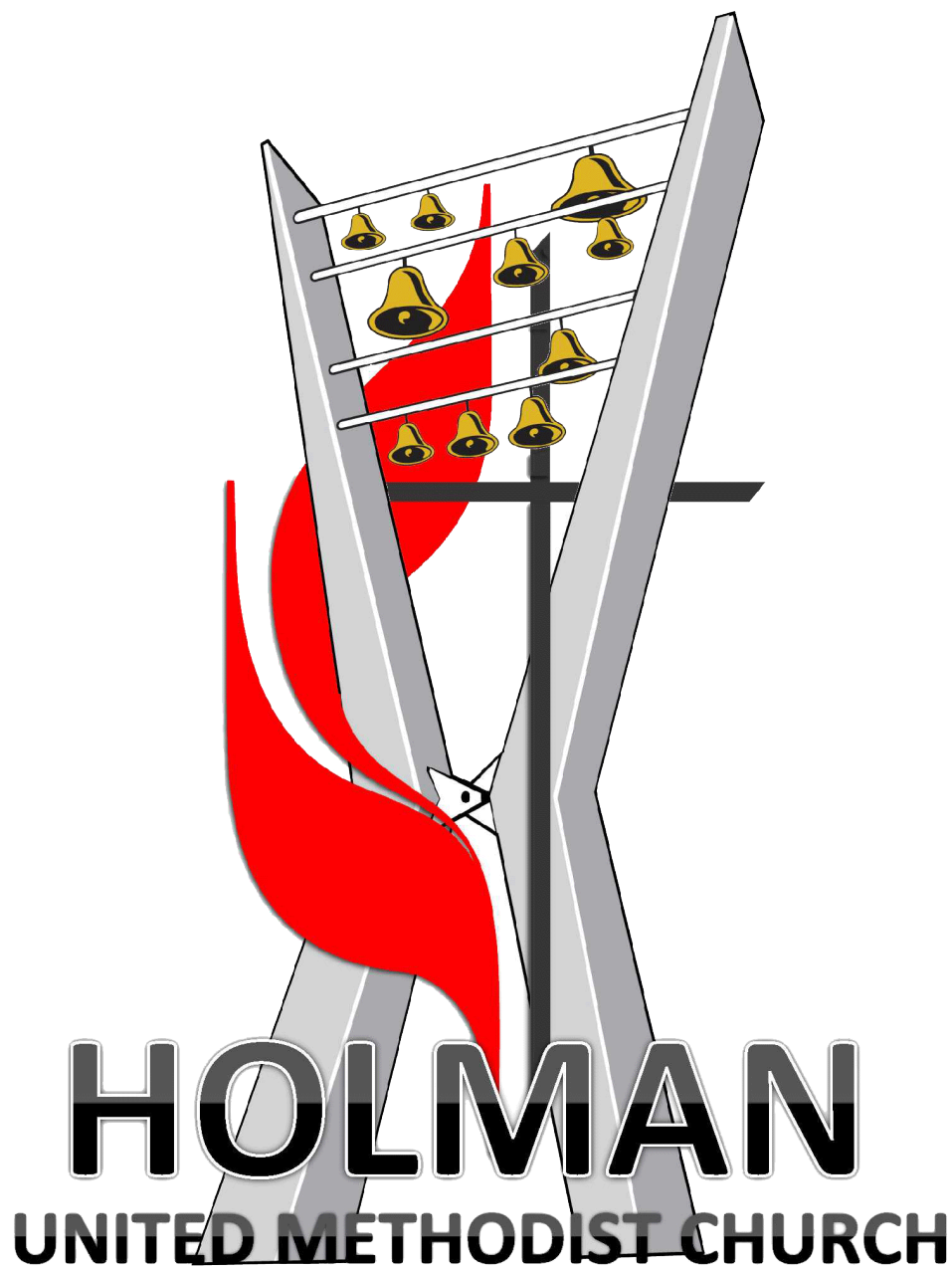
