Barista	 Greets and engages customers, creating a welcoming experience, while taking beverage and food orders. Specializes in coffee making, coffee recipes, and coffee orders.
Bartender	 Interacts with customers in a friendly and patient manner. Mixes and makes drinks for customers. Has a working knowledge of wines, liquor and cocktails.
Bar Back	 Assists bartender with preparation of drinks. Sets up bar for service and breaks it down. Stocks bar with glassware, liquor, ice, garnishes, etc.
Bell Attendant	 Greets guests and sets the tone for the hotel property. Assists guests with their luggage. Escorts guests to their hotel room.
Bus Person	Clears dirty dishes from table.Assists server with the customers' needs and refills.
Cashier	Handles monetary transactions with customers.Works with manager to record and store money.
Cook	 Prepares food. Sets up work stations and ingredients. Cuts and portions meat. Weighs and mixes ingredients. Complies with sanitation guidelines. Distributes garnished plates to staff.
Dishwasher Utility	 Operates dishwashing equipment/dishwasher. Maintains clean dishes in the kitchen. Cleans and sanitizes tables and work surfaces.
Food Runner	Delivers food to customers.
Front Desk Agent	 Registers hotel guests and assigns rooms. Coordinates room status updates to housekeeping. Processes guest check-outs.
Host Hostess	 Warmly welcomes guests to the establishment. Maintains positive guest relations. Escorts guests to their table. Provides guests with menu and service items.
Housekeeper Room Attendant House Attendant	 Cleans and prepares rooms for guests. Maintains housekeeping carts. Restocks amenities and bathroom supplies in rooms. Removes and replaces used linens and towels from the guest rooms.
Pantry Cook Cold Prep Cafeteria Worker	 Prepares a limited number of food items (salads, pastas, deli sandwiches). Takes customer orders. Serves food at counter or station.
Server	 Guides guests through menus, while demonstrating thorough knowledge of food, beverages, ingredients and allergens. Provides attentive service and takes food orders. Serves food and drinks to customers.
